Bradshaw, Harvey [#111265]. (Veteran.) Age 22. Residence Lewis, nativity Illinois. Enlisted Feb. 18, 1862. Mustered Feb. 18, 1862. Re-enlisted and re-mustered Feb. 22, 1864. Promoted Sixth Corporal May 30, 1864; Fourth Corporal Nov. 15, 1864; Third Corporal May 15, 1865; Second Corporal July 1, 1865. Mustered out July 24, 1865, Louisville, Ky.

Bradshaw, Henry L [#111262]. Age 26. Residence Cass County, nativity Illinois. Enlisted July 10, 1861. Mustered Aug. 8, 1861. Died of wounds Nov. 27, 1863, Say lor Ridge, Ga.

Bradshaw, Jeremiah [#11126]. Age 54. Residence Lewis, nativity Kentucky. Enlisted Aug. 15, 1861. Mustered Aug. 30, 1861. Discharged for disability Oct. 4, 1862, Memphis, Tenn.

Bradshaw, Victor M [#111261]. Age 31. Residence Lewis, nativity Ohio. Enlisted Feb. 18, 1862. Wounded in shoulder slightly Dec. 29, 1862, Vicksburg, Miss. Wounded in thumb severely June 27, 1863, Walnut Hills, La. Mustered out Feb. 21, 1865, Harrisburg, Pa., expiration of term of service.
