Description:

“In the name of God, Amen. I John P. Harper, of the County of Elbert and the State of Georgia, being in my proper senses and sound memory, do make and ordain this my last will and testament.

Item, First of all I give my soul to God, who gave it, hoping for the resurrection of life through Christ and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent manner as to the discretion of my executors, hereinafter named.

As for worldly goods, I give as follows

Item I desire that my just debts be first paid, and that the present crop of tobacco on hand and the ensuing crop be applied to that purpose and in case the same should not be adequate to discharge the whole of my debts then and in that case my executors hereinafter to be named will dispose of my part of the stock for the interprise of discharging the same.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Sarah Harper, two hundred and fifteen and one-half acres of land it being the tract whereon I now live. Also two hundred acres adjoining the said tract, it being part of the four hundred acre tract, also ten negroes, to wit: Pete, Bob, Joe, Pompey, Abraham, Sarah, Grace, Amy, Tiller, and Jinny, also all my stock of horses, except one which will be hereafter named, cattle, hogs, sheep, and goats. Also all my household and kitchen furniture except one bed and furniture and all my farming utensils, also one pair of cart wheels, to her and her heirs, forever.

Item I give unto my son in law, Middleton Woods two hundred acres of land it being the other moiety? Of the above recited four hundred acres, also six negroes to wit: Peter, James, Edmond, Cate, Jude and Winney.

Item I give unto my nephew William Wilkins Lenore, one lot in the town of Elberton adjoining James Kidd on the east side, also one negro boy known by the name of Stephen, one bed and furniture, one sorrel horse, known by the name of Dolphin, and saddle and bridle to be purchased by my executors, rifle gun and shot pouch and all my wearing apparel when he arrives at mature age or sooner at the discretion of my executors.

Item And lastly I do constitute and appoint my wife, Sarah and Middleton Woods, my whole and sole executrix and executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills, heretofore by me made. I witness my hand and seal this ninth day of June 1801.

First: I give my soul to God that gave it, hoping for the resurrection of life through Christ, and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent manner, at the discretion of my executors hereinafter named.

As for my worldly goods, after all debts and demands against the estate are paid and discharged, I give as follows to wit:

Item: I give and bequeath to my nephew William W. Lenore, five hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item: I give and bequeath to my niece Prudence Richardson, daughter of Walker Richardson, four hundred dollars to remain within hands of my executors until she arrives to mature age or marries, which sum of money may be put out on interest at the discretion of my executors hereinafter named.

Item: My will and desire is that all my negroes, viz: Peter, Bobb, Joseph, Pompey, Abraham, David, Sarah, Grace, Jinny, Tiller, and Amy, be set free, and I do hereby monument and utterly set free, the aforesaid negroes after the present crop is housed and entirely secured, and in order that the same may be completely affected, my will is that my executors petition the legislature to pass a law to that effect.

My will and desire is that my land including the dwelling house and premises where I now live with all the farming implements, all the stock of every kind and description, all the household and kitchen furniture, and all and every other article or thing that appertains to the house or land, my wearing apparel excepted be sold and after paying off all the debts and demands and the above legacies, my will and desire is that the balance of the money be equally divided between my son-in-law Middleton Woods and Sophy Walthall, relic of William Walthall of Chesterfield County and State of Virginia.

Lastily: I do constitute and appoint Middleton Woods, Nathaniel Hudson, Richard Hubbard, my whole and sole executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills heretofore by me made, as witness my hand in seal this 15th day of May 1802.

“In the name of God Amen. I, Webb Kidd of the county of Elbert & State of Georgia being very sick & weak in body but of Perfect Mind Senses & Memory do make and constitute my last Will & Testament. But principally & first I give & hoping at the Resurrection I shall receive the same again in peace, and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it to me & as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with I do give & dispose of in the following manner. The Plantation House & Land whereon I now live with all that appertains thereunto belonging. I do give unto my dearly beloved wife Elizabeth Kidd to be her dowfull rite & property enduring of her life and widowhood and if she dies before my youngest child, Webb comes or rises to the years of eighteen then the Plantation House & Land not to be broken up until he arrive to that year of age and then separately I give him my youngest son his free choice to take the House, Land & plantation for his own or otherwise to take Dick my negro boy if he lives & I further give him out of my Estate a horse & saddle, the saddle to have when he calls for it & the horse to be put in his possession when he arrive to the above mentioned years. The horse and saddle to be worth one hundred dollars, together with a good bed & furniture & which ever he chooses, the land or Dick. If it be the land & the rest or Dick & the rest then thats to be his only part or claim of my Estate—and to my dearly beloved daughter Nancy Harper [#211/1] I do give a beast & saddle, bed & furniture with one Heifer Cow which they have in their possession to the amount of ninety three dollars, and to my dearly beloved daughter Polly Jennings I do give which they have now in their possession one tract of land & one bed to the amount of one hundred & twenty five dollars, and to my dearly beloved daughter Lucy Greenwood I do give which they have had in their possession one bed & with a heifer cow, beast & saddle together with cash to the amount of one hundred & four dollars=& to my son William Kidd I do give which he now has in possession one tract of land a bed & furniture, beast & saddle to the amount of two hundred & thirty five dollars and to my beloved daughter Rhody Cleaveland I do give which she now has in possession one bed & furniture with a beast and saddle to the amount of Eighty five dollars the beast to yet be delivered to her—and to my beloved son Martin Kidd I do give which he has now in possession one tract of land lying in Franklin County & State of Georgia with a horse & saddle all to the amount of three hundred & ten dollars—and to my beloved son John Kidd I do give one tract of land lying in Franklin County joining of Martins Land with a Beast and Saddle all to the amount of three hundred & ten dollars & if the above mentioned land is ever lost by other claims the damage sustained shall be equally borne by all the legatees that is allowing them to return back into the Estate & sharing with the rest And as for the balance at the decease of my wife or age of my son Webb my Estate to be equally divided amongst all the legatees excepting my son Webb & Nancy Harper & Lucy Greenwood- and what so ever is coming to be Nancys part I do give to her daughter Polly & her son Webb -and what so ever might be Lucys part I do give to their son William and daughter Pol-

ly Greenwood, and I appoint and ordain my son Martin and William and John Kidd my sons to be my sole executors of this my Last Will & Testament and I do fully empower & authorize them to do and act for the good of the Estate & Legatees at their discretion as may deem most proper giving and assisting any of the Legatees when it can be spared out of the Estate= and I do hereby revoke & disnull all other wills and bequests ratifying and confirming this to be my Last Will & Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 16th day of August 1803”

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my Daughters, Elizabeth Dardin, Mary Jones, Lucy Howard, Ann Rucker and Drucilla Harper the sum of one dollar each.  
Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my son Bedford Harper and my Daughter Elender Harper, two tracts of land in the County of Wilkerson, that is to say, one in the ninth district and known by a plan of said district by lot number fifty eight and the other in the Twenty sixty District of said County and known by lot number Two hundred and Six.  
Fourthly, I give and bequeath all the balance of my Estate, not above specially willed to my aforesaid son Bedford Harper and Daughter Ellender Harper and my friend Beverly Allen to be equally divided amongst the three.  
Fifthly and Lastly, I constitute and appoint my beloved son Bedford Harper and my true and trusty friend, Beverly Allen, my executors to this my last will and testament, hereby revocating all former and other wills and testaments by me at any time heretofore made, and I do declare this to be my last will and testament.  
In Witnefs whereof to this my said will I have set my hand and seal the twenty seventh day of August in the year of our Lord, one thousand and eight hundred and ten and of American Independence the thirty fifth.
