"North Carolina Davidson County

Whereas on the 16" May 1884 Thos. Davis obtained an order from the Superior Court of Davidson County to sell the land hereinafter described belonging to the minor heirs of William E. Hauser [#31427] and whereas paid Thos. Davis Guardian of said minor heirs in presence of the authority granted in said order proceeded on the 4th day of August 1884 after due advertisement to sell said lands at public auction to the highest bidder when and where J. A. Sheek became the last and highest bidder at the price of one hundred and thirty five dollars.

Now therefore the said Thomas Davis Guardian as aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty five dollars to him in hand paid by J. A. Sheek the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has given granted, bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents does give grant bargain sell and convey unto the said J. A. Sheek his heirs and assigns the following described tracts of land lying and being in the County of Davidson on the waters of Yadkin River beginning at a stone and pointers the south east corner of lot No. 2 [?] on the line of lot No. 1 thence with said line S 50 E 10 1/2 poles to a stone, thence . . . containing 7 7/8 acres.

2nd lot wood land . . . in Sheek's line . . . near Lowder's corner . . . containing 5 3/4 acres. To have and to hold the said land and premises to him the said J. A. Sheek his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony thereof the said Thos Davis Guardian as aforesaid has hereunto set his hand and seal this 5" day of September 1884.

Johann Christian Loesch [#27/1]

Memoir of Br. Johann Christian Loesch, who blessedly fell asleep on 12 January 1844 at Bethania.

The blessed Brother was born on 25 December 1758 in Bethabara and soon afterward was resented to the Saviour to be his own property. When his parents betook themselves to Bethlehem, he, a boy of eight years, went with them and thereafter entered the school at Nazareth Hall. During this period, on 16 February 1772, he was received into the Gemeine Moravian Church. When the years of schooling came to an end, he went to Hope. New Jersey, to learn the blacksmith's craft and remained there for some time. But since the profession proved uncongenial to his health, on his own initiative he returned to Nazareth. There he spent his time making further progress in his education at the school.

When he was 20 years old he went back to North Carolina and stayed at the place of his birth, where he occupied himself in various ways for several years. He then decided to return to Pennsylvania. from whence he betook himself to Hope, New Jersey to learn the tanner's profession. When his year of service had ended, he came back to Salem. where he spent several years working as a day laborer. Then he went to work in the Community Store. During this period he felt obliged to renew formally his baptismal covenant. He therefore on 22 February 1783 attained the privilege of partaking of Holy Communion.

After serving here for a number of years, he entered into holy matrimony with the Single Sr. Gertrude Hauser on 11 January 1787, and they settled down in Bethabara in the employ of the Community Store there. After two years. however, the blessed Brother decided to change his place of residence. Accordingly, he moved in 1789 to Bethania, where he opened a store at his own risk.

The blessed Brother suffered no lack of trials whereby the faithful Saviour intended to prevail gradually over his heart. Indeed, on 9 May 1791 it pleased the Lord to remove his loyal wife from him through death, leaving him a distressed widower with two untrained daughters. His situation decidedly required that he remarry after a while. On 5 November 1793 he therefore entered upon marriage for the second time, indeed, with the Single Sr. Johanna Hauser. This marriage was blessed with two sons and one daughter. But though the Saviour thus had lovingly lifted the bitter grief from the blessed Brother, this respite likewise was soon to end, for on 27 August 1805 he found himself separated from this wife by death. His large family, however, required that he soon consider marrying again. Accordingly, on 15 July 1806 he entered upon matrimony for the third time — of course, with her who is presently his deeply distressed widow, the Single Sr. Anna Seiz. This marriage was blessed with two sons. May the Lord comfort her in her widowed state and cheer her with many a glimpse of his mercy, for she took care of the blessed Brother with untiring faithfulness during his advanced age. He lived to see 21 grandchildren from his children, as well as 25 great-grandchildren. Four of the grandchildren and six of the great-grandchildren, however, preceded him into eternity.

fered a blow mainly from a violent attack of colic, which he had endured several years earlier. Nevertheless, his energetic spirit always prevailed again over the weakness of his body, so that the latter did not succumb. Last autumn he was among those struck by the raging fever. Of course, he seemed to recover somewhat, but his strength diminished day by day until about a week ago, when he was obliged to take to his bed altogether. And all too soon it became clear that the Saviour was hastening to bring his tired little sheep into eternal rest. Last Wednesday, when he had grown noticeably weaker, his children and other sympathetic

friends were present in the evening, when, in a prayer, he was commended to the faithful Friend of Sinners and to His heart, which is full of love. Then the blessing of the Lord and of the Gemeine was bestowed upon him for his homeward journey. Nevertheless, he tarried here below for several more days. Then day before yesterday, at 5 o'clock in the evening — and after some hours of fierce pain — the Lord gently consummated his weary pilgrimage and led him into eternal rest, there to partake forevermore of the joys for which he had so yearned while here below. . . . His age had reached 85 years and 18 days.

George Hauser [#22]

Memoir of George Hauser, Jr. 1755-1818

He was born, Aug. 28, 1755, on his father's farm on the Yadkin River. When Bethania was begun his parents asked for and received permission to build there, whither they moved with their children in 1759 Our now departed Brother spent a cheerful and contented childhood, and in time learned the work of a smith from his father.

On March 3, 1778, [sic] he married Magdalena Schor, now his widow, and moved with her to a farm four miles from here. There he remained for some years, and during that time he appeared to have given up his close association with the congregation. Finally he again began to wish not only to be connected with the congregation but to live in the town, which was granted at his request. He moved here again in August 1780, living first in the house belonging to Brother Heinrich Spoenhauer, working in the smithy with his father; and also commenced planning to build for himself on a lot in town.

During the time of the Revolution he had one very unpleasant experience. When part of the English Army was camped in the neighborhood, some of the soldiers forced their way into his house, which he held in rent from Brother Spoenhaur, and in searching through the house they found in the cellar a number of casks of brandy, of which they drank so immoderately that they all got drunk. The officers, provoked by this, arrested our Brother, claiming that he was the owner of the house, and had given the brandy to the soldiers, dragged him into the street and left him there all night under guard in spite of a heavy rain. He declared his innocence, but the officers would not listen to him. On the following day the pastor of the congregation and other members interceded on his behalf, and he was finally set at liberty. On Dec. 17, 1780, he was received into the congregation; and on March 28, 1782, partook for the first time of the Lord's Supper with them. Having built a house he moved into it with his family, and carried on his handicraft for some years and until he entered into partnership with the now departed Brother, Johannes Conrad, who was conducting a store. This also did not last many years; and for a while he carried on the store alone and on his own account, and thereby laid the foundation for his later financial difficulties, and was soon obliged to give it up altogether. Meanwhile he had built a new and very large dwelling, and after the home-going of Brother George Peter Hauser, who had been tavern-keeper for many years, he undertook the lodging and feeding of visitors and travellers. By his friendly manner and willing service he soon won the love of members and strangers. But this willingness to serve was not always accompanied with sufficient foresight; and the state of his health did not permit him personally to oversee the house-keeping, which he must leave largely to others and to his negroes. Added to this was a constantly decreasing patronage of his tavern, which finally brought such ruin of his material affairs that he was in trouble on all sides, and a year ago found himself forced to sell everything in order to satisfy his creditors.

He served this congregation for many years as a member of the Committee; and served the County as a Justice of the Peace. Eight times he was elected a member of the Assembly of this

State. After selling his property here he and his wife moved,--on Oct. 9th--to his farm three miles from town. He was already sick and weak, and this weakness increased from day to day, and it was apparent that his journey here below would soon be ended, His last night was very restless, and he suffered much from oppression in the chest. Toward morning on the 3rd of this month he asked for a visit, but before his pastor could reach him a sudden attack brought his end, and he quietly fell asleep. His age was 63 year, 2 months and 5 days.

His forty years of marriage God blessed with ten children, of whom five in tender childhood passed into eternity before him. By those still living he had twenty-two grandchildren, of whom three are no more in life. His children bear witness that they had in him a tender and faithful father, always concerned about their success in life.

It is further ordered and decreed that the said Eugene Conrad after forty days advertisement at the Courthhouse door in Yadkinville and at theee or more other public places the County of Yadkin, proceed to sell said land at the Courthouse door aforesaid to the highest bidder at public auction on a credit of twelve months, taking bond and approved security for the payment of the purchase money and report to the next term of the Court. From which said decree of the Court & verdict the defendant prays an appeal to the next Spr Court. Appeal granted upon the Deft. giving security for the appeal. The Deft files his bond with J. M. Cloud as security, which is approved."
