Will of James Head [#1]

I James Head of Elbert Co., Ga being sick and weak but in perfect memory. I give to my loving wife Elizabeth Janett Head [#1/1] two negroes; one named Wigan and Sarah, with four feather beds and all my household furniture and working tools, my stock of hogs, cattle, two work horses and I lend my sorrel mare to my wife during her lifetime. I give to my dtr. Sarah Fortson [#11] one negro girl named Luscyc, one feather bed and furniture, saddle and bridle now in her possession. It is my will that my land on Vans Creek after the death of my wife be divided between my two sons Benjamin Simon Head [#15] and James Head [#16]. Each of my chn. from Martha [#12] down to James have received one negro, feather bed and furniture and saddle and bridle. My tract of land of 200 acres in Wilkes Co. on Kettle Creek be sold and pay my debts. I appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Janet Head executrix and Sally Riddle, Thomas White my executors. Dated this 23 Oct. 1795. Wit: William Head [#3], John Pol-lard and John Hose.

- Item 4: I give and bequeath unto my son John H. Fears [#16A/1, my rifle, also the following negroes heretofore by me loaned to him and now in his possession, to wit, Hampton valued at eight hundred dollars, Clary valued at five hundred dollars, Robert valued at four hundred dollars, Amis valued at three hundred dollars, Frances valued at one hundred fifty dollars and also one wagon and two mules valued at one hundred fifty dollars, all of which said property save said rifle together with the one thousand dollars by me heretofore advanced to him are to be by him accounted for according to the foregoing valuation and deducted from his share upon the final and general distribution of my estate.
- Item 5: I give and bequeath to my son James T. Fears the following negroes, to wit, Washington valued at twelve hundred dollars, Judy valued at eight hundred dollars and Foster a boy valued at four hundred dollars. All of which property together with the one thousand dollars by me heretofore advanced to him he is to account for according to the foregoing valuation and the same is to be deducted from his share in the general and final distribution of my estate.

All which said money and negroes so appraised shall be deducted from his share at the final and general distribution of my estate, it is my intention that he receive no hire for the negroes until he arrives at age or any interest on the money.

Fears and also the education of said children.
