“Mrs. Martha Anne Gathright Buried At Gansville Wednesday

Funeral services for Mrs. Martha Anne Gathright, 74 years of age, who died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. B. Puckett, at Georgetown, Tuesday, following an illness of three weeks with a stroke of paralysis, were held at the Gansville Baptist Church Wednesday afternoon. Interment was in the Gansville Cemetery. The Rev. Monk, of Jonesboro, had charge of the services.
