“JOSEPH LUCIEN GILBERT

J. L. Gilbert, postmaster and merchant of Berlin, passed away at the home of his sister, Mrs. A. M. Hammer, in Albany, Tuesday evening, January 10, following a long illness of heart trouble.

Mr. Gilbert was the oldest son of Professor J. L. Gilbert, one of the prominent educators of the state, and was born in Green Valley, Douglas county, January 21, 1859. He had spent all his life in Oregon. With his parents he came to Albany in 1875 when his father was elected principal of the Albany schools. From Albany the family moved to Lebanon, where Professor Gilbert was president of the Santiam academy and superintendent of Linn county schools for several years.

Mr. Gilbert, in partnership with his brother, E. L. Gilbert, has conducted a store and the post office at Berlin for the past 14 years. He went to Albany a few weeks ago on account of his illness and remained at the home of his sister until called by death.

He is survived by two sisters and one brother, Mrs. E. E. Montague of Portland, Mrs. A. M. Hammer of Albany, and E. L. Gilbert of Berlin.

He had long been a member of the Methodist church in Lebanon. He was an excellent man and was held in the highest esteem by his many friends.

The funeral service was held in the Methodist church in Albany Thursday afternoon, conducted by the Pastor, Rev. J. Spencer. A large number of friends from Berlin and Lebanon were present, and the pall bearers were A. L. Burrell, Elmer Burrell, M. S. Bellinger, L. Coppock, R. C. Roberts and Fred Fortmiller. Interment was in Riverside cemetery by the side of his sister, Miss Hela Gilbert, who preceded him several years ago.”
