Item I give & Devise to my son John Kertley [#31] three Tracks of Land in Orange County known by the Name of Bryans Trackt goldings Track & maddeys Containing six hundred acres & also a place called the grape Thicket in Augustia County & the Land On Nacked Creak of my part of the Land where [Rulin?] Reach Lives to him And his heirs & the negroes named Peter Smith [Knat?] Jeane & Little Jason

Item I give & Devise to my Daughter Eleazabeth Kertley [#33] the Land I Bought of Eastises Estate known by the name of Purkeys Old Mill place to her & her heirs

Item I give & Devise to my son honourias Powell Kertley [#34] the Land which Lies on the south side of Buns Run marked By three poplars it Being one part of the Land I Now Live on to him & his heirs

Item I give & Devise to my son Sinkler Kertley [#35] all the Land that I own on the north side of Buns run and from them three poplars above named to him & his heirs

Deed of Elisha Estes and Gabriel Long to Thos. Kirtley [#2], formerly partly proved at November Court, 1774, is now fully proved by Francis Kirtley, Jr. [#32], but the Court refuses to have it recorded because said Kirtley refuses to pay the tax of 3 pp hundred acres.

Conrad vs. Kirtley--O. S. 112; N. S. 38--Bill, 31st July, 1806. Orator is Stephen Conrad of Rockingham. About 1769 Honorius Powell of Orange County died. The widow, Jennett Powell, compromised with the children as to the property. Nathaniel Allen and Robert Royston intermarried with two of the granddaughters of Jennett, and were living in Georgia. St. Clair Kirtley [#35] was also Jennett's grandson, with whom she lived, but became dissatisfied and lived at orator's house until her death. (On the cover of this bill is the following: "I put this cover on between 7 and 8 o'clock on Thursday morning, September 26, 1839, and a very cold morning it was. The Clay Convention is in session in Staunton at this time and is the second day of its meeting. A. R. St. Clair, aged 39 years, against the 22d of October next. Lord! Whose eye will this meet when I am in eternity".) Jennett Powell's will of Rockingham County, dated 16th March, 1803, proved in Rockingham November, 1807. To daughters of James Riddles, viz: Wineford married to Hillas Oliver; Mary, Frances, Lucy; to daughter of James Riddle, Jr., named Mary; to daughter of Francis Kirtley [#32] named Jennett [#328]; to John Bell's [#33/1] and Francis Kirtley's children.

"In the name of God Amen, I Francis Kirtley being, through the abundant mercy of God in perfect health of body & mind, & of perfect senses Blessed be God but Calling to Mind ye certainty of Death and the uncertainty of life Do therefore constitute & appoint this to be my last Will and Testament & desire it may be received by all as such and I do Utterly Revoke all former Wills by me heretofore made.

Imprimis I give my Body to the Ground from whence it was taken in full Assurance of its Resurrection at the last Day & as for my burial I desire it may be Decent without Pomp or State at the Discretion of my dear wife & executors hereafter Named.

Item I give & bequeath to my Dearly Beloved Wife Margaret Kirtley [#1] one Negro Girl named Luck to her & her heirs forever. Also I lend my Dearly Beloved Wife during her life one Negro fellow Named Shaddach & one Negro Wench Named Doll, one Feather Bed & furniture her Choice, one Chest, two Pots, two Dishes half a Dozen Plates two Basins, one pail & Piggins, two Cows & Calves her Choices - half a Dozen Sheep, one mare known by the name of Pleasure & her Saddle, half a Dozen Chairs, & the rents of the Lands & Plantations whereon John Mocarlie & John Forester now Lives during her life & after her Decease the Land wheron John Mocarlie lives to fall to my Son William Kirtley [#1] & the Land Whereon John Forester lives to fall to my son James Kirtley [#4] to them and their heirs forever & the remainder to be sold to the Highest Bidder & the Money to be Equally Divided among my Children William Kirtley, Thomas Kirtley [#2], Francis Kirtley [#3] & James Kirtley, Sarah Cowherd [#5] and Mary Collins [#6].

Item I give & bequeath to my son William Kirtley the lott of land whereon John Mocarlie Now lives lying below Farrier Run (or Farrow Run) to him & his heirs forever.

Item - I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Kirtley one hundred & Eighty Acres of Land joining the Corner of John Delany & Joseph Bosson from thence to the North of Garths Run lying on the South Side of Stanton River Joining Stanton's line & one Bed & furniture his Choice after my wife's Choice -

Item, I give & Bequeath to my son Francis Kirtley one Tract of land lying on the Blue Ridge on the head of the South River in Orange County like wise twelve Estates of Land in Augusta County to him and his heirs forever -

Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Kirtley all the Remainder of the Tract of Land whereon I live together with two hundred Acres of Land that I Bought of George Hume, one Negro Boy Named George & one Negro Girl Named Hinney to him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Collins three Hundred & Ten Acres of Land lying on the Branches of Conway Joining Conway's land to her and her heirs Forever -

Item, It is my Desire that Jonathan Cowherd [#5/1] shall Keep the Plantation & Land whereon he now lives & Quietly Possess the same till the year One Thousand seven hundred & Sixty

Eight for the Rent of his Plantation at Swift Run Gap which Rent is to be paid to James Kirtley  
Item, I leave all the Remainder of my Estate Lands, Negros, Goods & Chattel to be sold to the Highest Bidder at Twelve Months Credit and the Money thereby arising to Discharge all my just Debts & the Remainder to be Equally divided among my Dear Wife & Children before Named.  
Lastly I constitute & appoint my Beloved Wife Margaret Kirtley, William Kirtley, Thomas Kirtley, Francis Kirtley & James Kirtley Executors of this my Last Will and Testament in Witness wherof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 22nd Day of November, 1762.

[The plus sign is not the "X" signature of an illiterate person, which would usually be accompanied by the note: His Mark. The plus sign is a cross with loop at the bottom as in the letter J. This may be the sign of the cross made upon the letter J, standing for Jesus Christ, and indicating the Christian faith of Francis Kirtley. L.S is an abbreviation for the Latin: Locus Sigilli, the place of the seal. The original will would have been hand copied by the county recorder into a large ledger book, and the location of a seal on the original could have been indicated by L.S. or by simple writing the word "seal" surrounded by a wavy circle.]

"In the name of god amen, I William Kirtley senior of the County of Madison & State of Virginia being through the abundant mercy of god having (though weak in boddy) continued in perfect sences of mind blessed be god for it - but collecting to mind the certainty of death and the uncertainty of life - do therefore make, constitute, and ordain this to be my last will & testament - and I desire it may be received by all as such and I utterly Revoke all former Wills by me here to fore made.

Imprimus I give my boddy to the ground from whence it was taken in full assurance of its resurrection at the last day - and as for my burial It may be decent with out pomp or state at the discrestion of my Dear wife & Executors here after named.

I lend to my dearly beloved wife Sarah Kirtley [#1/1] during her natural life all that tract of land I now live uppon adjoining together lying uppon the Stanton river - allso one other tract of land known by the name of the Mill tract containing one hundred and Eighty three acres which I purchased of my brother James Kirtley [#4] together with the mill standing on the aforesaid river.

I lend to my dearly beloved wife Sarah Kirtley during her natural life Eleven negroes (& their increase) that is to say Dinah, Patrick, Ben, George, Coleman, Cupett, Rose, Folsich, Pippen, Baylor & Ester. Also all my household furniture (clock only excepted) and all my Kitchen furniture & Stock of all kinds consisting of horses, cattle, sheep & hogs & all my plantation tools & one waggon & gear & two stills.

My Will & desire is that all my negroes shall continue to work uppon my home, home plantation & the mill plantation, to the end of the year, that my death takes place and the whole crop made on booth these plantations to be sold by my Executors here after named for the best price that can be had & the money arising the sales of the said crops to be applied to the payment of my Just Debts, Except the Crop of the two negroes Baylor & Ester which negroes is in possession of my son William Kirtley [#11]. Said Crop made by them that year my death takes place my Will & desire is shall continue the property of Said son William Kirtley.

I give and bequeath to my son William Kirtley (after the death of my beloved wife Sarah Kirtley) all that part of this tract of land I now live uppon lying South & South West of a line to begin at a corner at the Arbor spring at three white oaks a corner in John Delany's line and thence by a line of marked trees to a corner standing by a large rock at the foot of a hill near the Stanton river. Said rock & corner is on the West side of sade river thence running the same course of the last mentioned line to be continued till it stricks my old pattent line next to Alexander Simpson's, to him the said William Kirtley his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Jeremiah Kirtley [#13] (after the death of my beloved wife Sarah Kirtley) all that part of this tract of land I now live uppon (not to Extend to my Mill tract) lying North of a line to begin at a corner at the Arbour Spring at three white oakes a corner in John Delany's line & is a corner to William Kirtley Jr., thence with a line of marked trees to a corner standing by a large rock at or near the foot of a hill on the West bank of the Stanton river thence continuing the same course of the last mentioned line & binding uppon the tract

just willed to William Kirtley Jr., till it stricks my old pattent line next to Alexander Simpsons together with my dwelling house, out houses & orchards which stands upon the said tract of land I give to him my son Jeremiah Kirtley his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my son William Kirtley (after the Death of my beloved wife Sarah Kirtley) two negroes that is to say Baylor & Ester and allso all the Increase of the said Ester to him the said William Kirtley his heir & Assigns forever.

My will & desire is that at the End of the year which my death takes place in, that my Executors hear after named Shall then Immediately procede to sell for ready money the following slaves, Oliver, Nan, Thill, King, Eve, Cate, Taney, Will, Juddy, Jacob & Rachel & their Increase they or each of them may have before the day of sale. Allso one clock & also any other articles that my wife Sarah Kirtley Should Choose to give up to be sold on the day of sale (and the money arising from the said sales shall be Equally Divided between my five Children William Kirtley, Elijah Kirtley, Jeremiah Kirtley, Margaret Bauford & Elizabeth Davis to them their hairs & assigns forever.

My will & desire is (that after the death of my beloved wife Sarah Kirtley) that all the Slaves & their Increase together with all the other personal Estate that I have here to fore lent to my wife Sarah Kirtley during her life two negros excepted Baylor & Ester which I have given heretofore, shall at her death, be sold by my Executors (here after named) for ready money & the money arising from the said sales shall be Equally divided between my five Children William Kirtley, Elijah Kirtley, Jeremiah Kirtley, Margaret Bauford & Elizabeth Davis to them their heirs & assigns forever.

My will & desire is that my Executors hear after named Shall collect all the money due me by bill Bond or open Account and apply the same to the payment of my Just debts - and the balance of money which may be left in their hands after discharging my debts my will & desire is shall be Equally divided between my five children William Kirtley, Elijah Kirtley, Jeremiah Kirtley, Margaret Bauford & Elizabeth Davis to them their heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my two grandsons namely Elijah Kirtley [#111] & Elliott Kirtley [#113] (sons of my son William Kirtley) the sum of Fifty pounds specia each, to be paid to them, out of the first money which my Executors hereafter name Shall collect of the money which are due me either by Bond or other wise, to them the said Elijah Kirtley & Elliott Kirtley, their heirs & assigns forever.

I do here by constitute & appoint my son Jeremiah Kirtley & my son in law Isaac Davis [#15/1], Addam Banks my whole & sole Executors to this my last will & testament revoking all other wills here to fore made declaring this to be my only & last will & testament In witness here of I William Kirtley Sen. have here unto sett my hand & affixed my seal this 3rd day of March one thousand seven hundred & ninety five.

First my will and desire is that my Exors hereafter named & after discharging all my Funeral Expenses & shall proceed to pay all my Just debts out of the profits & arising from my Estate but if my Creditors will not wait so long, Then my will and desire is that my Executors hereafter named shall then proceed to sell such of my moveable Estate as in their opinion can be best spared on six months Credit taking bond and good security of the purchasers and to apply the money arising from such sales in the payment of my Just debts

And whenever my wife Dorothy Kirtley's death, shall take place or she shall marry, Then the aforesaid land, Negroes and other property shall be disposed of as is hereafter directed.

To Reuben Cowherd [#57] (my son-in-law) four boys by name of Bob, Benjamin, Aadam & Patrick, two negroes woman by name of Bilate and Dinah & one girl by name of Judah.

In the name of God Amen I, Joel S. Graves, of the County of Rockingham State of Virginia being weak in body but of a sound and disposing memory do make this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say

First of all I desire and will that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid and for this purpose order that all my perishable property be sold together with all my land lying in the following bounds: beginning on the county line of Rockingham and Shenandoah near a \_\_\_\_\_; thence following the County line to the top of Chapman’s Mountain not far from Hepner(?)’s Gap; thence following the top of the Mountain to Daniel Utz land; thence leaving Geo Utz’ land to the east and pursuing the mountain to a corner which Jonce (?) made for John Deets and then with the lines of that survey to the foot of the Mountain to a corner of said survey; thence around the foot of the Mountain in a north west direction with the lines of the Big Survey so-called to the beginning (except my slaves) by my executors hereinafter to be named. And if that should prove insufficient to pay my debts, I order and will the land in the following bounds be also sold to aid in the discharge of my just debts, that is to say: Beginning on the top of Chapman’s Mountain and pursuing the County to the top of the long ridge near the Maple Spring thence along the top of said Ridge to a Deep Hollow; thence down the Hollow to Branch crossing said Branch and N. Naked Creek to Utz’ said line and with his line and to the top of the mountain; and thence with a line of the first mentioned tract to the beginning. Should this still prove insufficient, I order a part of the land I hold in the county of Orange be also sold and the proceeds applied in discharge of my debts. To wit: beginning at the angle of Rockingham and Orange County line and pursuing the Orange line down as far as my line extends and then with my patent line to the top of a ridge nearly opposite old Mrs. Booton’s and thence up the ridge to the top of the mountain; thence along the mountain to the beginning.

Next I give and devise to my son James the tract of land I had one surveyed for John Deets of which I hold a plat containing about eleven hundred acres with the exception what I sold Jacob Bear to be good to him, his heirs and assigns forever.

3rd Item. I give and devise to my daughter Sarah Daniel five hundred acres of land beginning at the Rock Bridge and corner to James’ land and Bear land thence crossing south Naked Creek to the top of the Mountain from thence to a large High Rock near Powell’s Creek and then in such a direction around to James’ land as to include the said five hundred acres to be good to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

4th Item. I give to my daughter Nancy Hammer, her heirs and assigns forever the land included in the following bounds that is to say: Beginning on Folands (?) Line on the top of a Ridge opposite to where Smith once lived; thence up the said Ridge to Ben. Powell’s line and with his lines to Beesley’s lines and directly on the Branch that comes down from Beesley’s; thence down the Branch to Foland’s lines and with thence to the beginning.

5th Item. I give and bequeath to my son Joel Asher his heir and assigns forever five hundred acres of land beginning at a small hickory (where two red oaks stood) corner to the Wycick’s place; thence along the lines of the Wydick’s place to Geo. Utz land and with his lines on to the top of the mountain and thence down to south Naked Creek crossing the creek to a large pine across said branch and near the ford continuing the course to the top of the mountain on

- Ridge on the south side of the creek; thence to the white (sic) near the Road and Corner of the Wydick's tract; thence with a line of the same to the beginning so as to include the five hundred acres.
- 6th Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter, Cinthia, her heirs & assigns forever five hundred acres of land including the plantation where Joseph Samuel now lives. Beginning at the S. Naked Creek where Joel A. crosses and thence up the Creek to the lock; thence up the right hand prong to the mouth of Aggy's Run; thence up that branch to said Aggy's Run; up from thence in such a direction to Joel A. corner on the top of the mountain on the South side of Naked Creek and with line to the beginning as to take in the five hundred acres.
- 7th Item. I give and bequeath to my son Harden, his heirs and assigns forever five hundred acres of land beginning at the mouth of Aggy's Run and running up Jack's prong two hundred and fifty poles from thence to a place called Buck Thorough Fare from thence around in such direction as will include the five hundred acres.
- 8th Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Drucilla Strole, her heirs and assigns forever five hundred acres of land beginning on the county line of Rockingham and Shenandoah at a corner of the land directed to be sold near the Maple Spring and thence with that line along the top of the ridge two hundred and fifty poles Thence leaving the top of the ridge nearly at right angles crossing Naked Creek and pursuing that course for enough as to include five hundred acres of land in nearly a square.
- 9th Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth, her heirs & assigns five hundred acres of land lying in between the land given to Drucilla Strole and Joel A. to be laid out in the most suitable manner for a farm.
- 10th Item. I give and bequeath to my two Grand Sons Joel Smith and Walter Riley Thomas their heirs and assigns for ever five hundred acres of land to be laid off between Jack's and Thomas Creeks to begin in the fork of the creeks and pursuing each branch far enough to include five hundred acres.
- 11th Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Frances, her heirs and assigns forever two hundred and fifty acres of land including the place adjoining Jack's place so called where James Breeding now lives Beginning at a poplar and locust tree corner to Thomas Graves' and with his line to a poplar sump. Thence with the same degrees towards a place called Turkey Head thence at a right angle two hundred poles from Thence in a direction to the Slippery Rocks Branch where the path crosses said branch from thence in such direction around including the clear land and we will take in the two hundred and fifty acres.
- 12th Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Jane Crop her heirs and assigns forever my undivided moiety of the Jacks place so called and when it is divided I order and direct that one hundred and fifty acres more of wood land shall be added to the half allotted me to lie along the side of it.
- 13th Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Susan her heirs and assigns forever five hundred acres of land including the place which Benjamin Hensley and Elijah Breeden now lives to begin at the place where I directed my Daughter Nancy Hammer to begin on the ridge opposite Smith's old house on a line of Foland's Land; and, thence up the ridge with Hammer's line to Powell's line then around towards Berrey's land in such a direction as will include the said five hundred acres. And if in the future it shall so turn out that the place where Benjamin Hensley and Elijah Breeding now lives shall be lost by any prior or older right that in that case I order and will that my daughter Susan shall be compensated by other land of equal value.
- 14th Item. I give and bequeath of my Daughter Betty Rains, her heirs and assigns forever a small piece of land lying between Berry's, Jacob Miller's and William Rain's land being fifteen acres more or less together with a Negro girl named Mariah and her two children which she had while belonging to me and what household furniture, stocks etc. I gave her heretofore.

I desire it to be understood that my son-in-law William Hammer has a Negro girl in his possession named Ann and which I wish him to return to my family of Negroes to be disposed of agreeable to my own wish and if he refuses to return her I will and order that he shall be excluded from any farther devise on or part of my estate by his wife.

And farther I will and order that my slaves shall be equally divided among my several children here named, that is: James; Sarah Daniel; Hardin; heirs of my Daughter Elizabeth Thomas decd, namely Joel Smith and Walter Riley Thomas; Drucilla Strole; Cinthia; Elizabeth; Frances; Jane Crop; Susan; Joel Asher; and Nancy Hammer provided her husband William Hammer returns the Negro Girl Ann now is his possession otherwise to be excluded. And all such other lands and property which I own and not herein particularly given or devised I will and order that be sold by my Executors to the best advantage on a reasonable credit and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between all my children herein named provided they comply with the preceding requestitions of this Will.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend George Conrad and my son James Executors of this my Last Will and Testament revoking all other or former wills by me heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixteenth day of April one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine.

First and principally Being Sorry and pinetant for my Sins I commit my sole into the hands of the Almighty god in whome and by whose mercy I trust to be and absurdly Believe to be Saved and my body I commit to the earth to be deceantly Buried by and at the discretion of my Executors herein after named and for the disposing of such temporal estate which it hath pleased god to bless me with. I do give devise and dispose of the same in manner and firm as following that is to say

Firstly I give and devise to my Beloved wife Molly Powel a support on the place that my son Honorias Powel is to have during her natural life or widowhood and two negros Jude and Pink with necessaries of stock and household furniture for her use during her life or widowhood.

Item I have given to my son Benjamin Powel and my daughter Betsy Powel a tract of land called the grape thicket which I purchased from St. Clair Kirtly [#35] and that is to be their share of my landed estate.

- Item I give and devise to my Daughter Fanny Powel a tract of land containing fifty acres more or less which I purchased from Thomas Barber lying in Orange County on the side of the blue ridge to the south of my house and the larger part of the tract which I purchased from Daniel Baugher containing one hundred ninety seven acres lying on the blue ridge to the south of the farm on which I now live and her boundary line on the North is to run with the butter wood spring branch to her and her heirs and the said Fanny Powel is to leave open the road that leads to the Shiflet place so that my son Jeremiah can go and return.
- Item I give and devise to my Daughter Milly Shiflet my half of the tract of land which I purchased from Thomas Barber and which was taken up by Frances Kirtley [# ?] containing in the whole one hundred and fifty acres more or less and lying in Rockingham County on the top of the blue ridge, and sixty acres of a tract of land which I purchased from Thomas Barber and which was purchased by him from Philip Bush and joining the land I purchased from Thomas Barber and which I have given to my Daughter Milly to her and her heirs forever.
- Item I give and devise to my two sons Robert and Chapman Powel the land which I purchased from Isac Smith containing by pattenent one hundred and seventy six acres lying in Orange County on the top of the blue ridge on the north side of the Swift run road and all my still tubs are to stay on the place for the use of my two sons just above named, to them and their heirs forever.
- Item I give and devise to my son Jeremiah Powel the tract of land which I purchased from Stephen Shiflet containing one hundred and fifty od acres lying on the top of the mountain in Rockingham County to him his heirs forever.
- Item I give and devise to my son Garrot Powel the tract of land which I purchased from John Yansey containing about one hundred and eighty acres lying in Rockingham County on the drain of the hawksbill creek and that part of the tract which lies west of the mountain road which I purchased from George Baugher and Nicholas Baugher executors of Daniel Baugher Dec'd. and a little part I swapped with James Rogers for to him and his heirs forever.
- Item I give and devise to my son Honorius Powel the tract of land which I now live on and which was Deeded to me by Joshua Bush containing by deed eighty five and a half acres lying in Rockingham County on the top of the blue ridge and it is my will that the best still, all the barrels and stand tubs for the use of my son Honorius Powel and my wife Molly Powel shall stay on the place and I also give to my son Honorius Powel the two tracts which I Purchased from James Meddows, containing by deed ninety seven acres lying on the west side of the blue ridge in Rockingham County and I also give to my son Honorius Powel three pieces of land which are to be taken of three different tracts. First the remaining part of the tract which I purchased from Thomas Barber and which he purchased from Philip Bush Secondly the part of the tract which lies North of the butterwood spring and spring branch it being a smaller part of the tract which I purchased from Daniel Baugher and thirdly the part of the tract which lies on the east side of the mountain road which was purchased by me from George and Nicholas Baugher containing in the whole tract two hundred acres and one rood lying in Rockingham County on the west side of the blue ridge it being the remaining part of a tract which I have given to my son Garrot Powel, to my son Honorius and his heirs forever.
- And it is my desire that my negros Crumel and Lewis with the remaining part of my movable estate be sold at twelve months credit and that after my just debts are discharged the remaining part of the money is to be equally divided between my childring above named and it is my desire that if either of my above named childring shall die without an heir Lawfully begotten of their body that their part of my above named estate shall fall to the other of my childring to be equally divided among them and it is my desire that after my beloved wife Molly Polly shall depart this life or marry that her estate shall be sold and equally divided among my above named childring.

It is my desire that if the title of either of my above tracts of land should not be good the child to whom I have willed it shall receive its value from the sales of my moveable estate. It is also my desire that my friend St. Clair D. Kirtley [#35|#353] and my son Garrot Powel shall be the executors to my estate. Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty second of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine.
