“Bethal Lee Rye, 97, of Russellville, died Saturday, November 13, 2004, at Legacy Lodge Nursing Home.

Born February 18, 1907 at Mulberry, Arkansas, she was the daughter of the late Louis Edgar Shambarger and the late Mary Donie Whitlock Shambarger. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, where she was active in all phases of the churchwork in addition to participating in various community services. Other than her parents, her husband, Charles Emmett Rye, Sr., and two brothers, William Edgar and James Daw Shambarger preceded her in death.
